

Screen 114 changes effective 04/29/2005:

Screen 114 has been modified to no longer change the insurance deduction codes from a '3' (bill over the summer) to a '1' (take four months in May) when signing an employee up for the Extended Pay Plan. If an employee chooses to be billed over the summer, they cannot participate in EPP. This change was necessary because of employees who have SGIP start dates in the summer months. These employees can only be set up as deduction code '3'.

UIN Manager changes effective immediately:

Central Administrators now have the ability to enter temporary SSNs when creating new UINs. This should help alleviate problems with foreign nationals getting access to training through HRConnect and Single Sign On.

Changes to SGIP Rate effective immediately:

The SGIP rate of an active employee working below 50% effort will default to 'N'. This includes graduate students. Also effective is an 'N' SGIP rate being allowed for those on Unicare (medical carrier 03).

Summary of Graduate Student SGIP Supplements report available

A new quarterly report is currently available showing a summary of graduate student SGIP supplements. Based on **source** part, this report calculates totals using object classes '1794', '1795', '1796', '1797', and '1798' from payrolls of the previous month. The summary includes totals for the following by adloc part and department, with a grand total shown for source part:

- SGIP amount
- Number of graduate students
- Number of each type of coverage (e.g. Family, Employee Only)
