Screen 101 Change – Foster Child Status Added

The Texas A&M University System will now maintain the Foster Child status of an employee to assist in complying with HB 1043 of the 81st legislature:

HB 1043, Orr

Relating to the creation of an employment preference at state agencies for certain former foster children.

This bill creates an employment preference for an individual age 25 or younger who was under the permanent managing conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services on the day preceding the individual's 18th birthday over other applicants for the same position who do not have a greater qualification. Effective September 1, 2009.

The field is identified as Foster Chld on screen 101 and the valid values are Y and N. If it is left blank, screen 101 will default to N. Y will not be allowed if the employee is older than 25 on the employment date. The value will be set to N for all records currently in the BPP System. This change is effective immediately.
