In accordance with Section 2107.005 of the Government Code, the annual debt report for The Texas A&M University System (State of Texas Agency 710) is respectfully submitted.

As of August 31, 2007, the total delinquent accounts receivable for our agency was \$1,518,228.20 as reported by our Office of Technology Commercialization (OTC). These receivables represent funds owed to The Texas A&M University System for royalty and patent income. Of this amount, \$169,579.00 is estimated to be uncollectible.

There were no other delinquent amounts outside of The Texas A&M University System, no accounts evidenced by a promissory note, and no outstanding account balances reduced to judgment.
