

General Safety

1.0 GENERAL

- 1.1 Affected components shall develop and implement a General Safety Program as necessary to successfully manage general hazards and to protect students, employees and visitors.
- 1.2 The General Safety Standard is intended to provide guidance for managing hazards and risks not addressed elsewhere in the System environmental health and safety standards.

2.0 REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Affected components with general safety risks and exposures should
 - 2.1.1 Identify, document and analyze general workplace hazards and risks
 - 2.1.2 Develop and implement standard operating procedures to reduce risk to employees, students and visitors
 - 2.1.3 Provide and document training to affected personnel prior to exposure
- 2.2 The general safety program should address general safety hazards and risks present in the workplace(s). A listing of potential general safety topics is available from the A&M System Office of Risk Management and Safety.
