Change the Conversation...

Typical Approach =

"It's the RIGHT thing to do!"

Tends to be "challenge" & deficit focused

- Lost opportunities/years, Disability, Transition Challenges, Family Separation, Combat, etc.
- Tends to be focused on the past
- Uses metrics of sacrifice & service
- Emotional appeal that will "get you in the door..."

Data Changes the Conversation

Practical Approach =

"It's the SMART thing to do!"

- Should be "strengths" focused
 - New Opportunities & Service, Leadership Potential, Partnerships for Impact, etc.
- Focus on the Future
- Uses metrics of success & potential
- Practical appeal to "seal the deal..."
